Exclusions

- Received in transfer from another acute care or critical access hospital, including another emergency department
- No working diagnosis of pneumonia at the time of admission
- Receiving comfort measures only⁴ above
- Do not receive antibiotics during the hospitalization or within 36 hours (2160 minutes) from the time of hospital arrival
- 18 years of age
- Received antibiotics within 24 hours prior to hospital arrival
- Involved in protocols or clinical trials
- No chest x-ray or CT scan that indicated positive infiltrate within 24 hours prior to hospital arrival or anytime during this hospitalization
