Exclusions

The denominator has six exclusions:

- Patients less than 18 years of age
- Patients who are cognitively impaired
- Patients who are not current tobacco users
- Patients who refused or were not screened for tobacco use during the hospital stay.
- Patients who have a duration of stay less than or equal to day or greater than 120 days
- Patients with Comfort Measures Only documented
