Patients who received the following substance use screenings at least once within the last 24 months AND who received an intervention for all positive screening results: Tobacco use component Patients who were screened for tobacco use at least once within the last 24 months AND who received tobacco cessation intervention if identified as a tobacco user Unhealthy alcohol use component Patients who were screened for unhealthy alcohol use using a systematic screening method at least once within the last 24 months AND who received brief counseling if identified as an unhealthy alcohol user Drug use component (nonmedical prescription drug use and illicit drug use) Patients who were screened for nonmedical prescription drug use and illicit drug use at least once within the last 24 months using a systematic screening method AND who received brief counseling if identified as a nonmedical prescription drug user or illicit drug user
