Importance

Analysis for the HCBS ACSC measure is aggregated at the state level. Analysis of the measure's performance gap is presented in **Exhibit 1**, below. **Exhibit 1** displays the distribution of performance scores and denominator counts across the measure's three rates—chronic conditions, acute conditions, and total conditions. The denominator includes eligible Medicaid HCBS participants in the measurement year.
