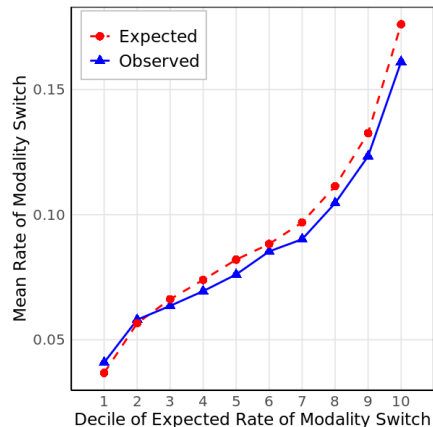


5.4.5a Attach Calibration and Discrimination Testing Results

CBE ID 5598, Standardized Modality Switch Ratio for Incident Dialysis Patients (SMoSR)

The estimated c-statistic for SMoSR was 0.611.

Risk decile plots show that higher deciles of predicted rate are associated with higher observed rate, indicating general well model calibration across risk strata.



Interpretation of Risk/Case-mix Factor Findings

Discrimination

The c-statistic of 0.611 indicates moderate model discrimination, reflecting the model's ability to distinguish high-risk from low-risk subjects.

Calibration

Observed modality switch rates increased monotonically across predicted risk deciles, suggesting that the model provides meaningful separation of patient risk groups. The overall agreement between predicted and observed rates indicates acceptable calibration for population-level performance assessment.
