

## The Kidney Health Evaluation for People with Diabetes and/or Hypertension Measure: Flowchart for Inclusion and Exclusion of Patients in the Measure

The goal of the Kidney Health Evaluation Measure is to improve the rate of kidney health evaluations in people with diabetes and/or high blood pressure using two lab tests called estimated glomerular filtration rate [eGFR] and urine albumin-creatinine ratio [uACR]. These two tests can identify people with chronic kidney disease so they can receive treatment to delay disease progression and improve their kidney health.

The purpose of this flowchart is to show the logic of how the Measure inclusion and exclusion criteria will determine the numerator and denominator populations for this Measure.
