# Introduction

Battelle conducts the Pre-Rulemaking Measure Review (PRMR) process annually to provide recommendations on the selection of quality and efficiency measures under consideration for use in select Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) programs.

We organize measures under review into three setting-specific committees: Post-Acute Care/Long-Term Care (PAC/LTC), Clinician, and Hospital.

Committees have an Advisory Group (30-35 people) and a Recommendation Group (25-30 people). The Advisory Group provides feedback and questions about the measures that help guide Recommendation Group discussion. Based on that input, as well as public comments, the Recommendation Group renders final recommendations to CMS about which measures to use.

Committee members serve a 3-year term, with time on both the Advisory Group and Recommendation Group throughout their tenure. The Advisory and Recommendation Group assignments in this roster only apply to the 2026-2027 PRMR cycle.

Please note, PRMR members may be organizational or individual members. Organizational members represent their organization's interest while an individual member represents their own perspective and experience.

Members of federal agencies may also serve on PRMR committees as non-voting federal liaisons. CMS, in collaboration with Battelle, identifies which federal agencies should participate based on the specific programs and measures under discussion.

Nominees provide their biographies. Battelle uses artificial intelligence (AI) to summarize them, and staff review the final versions. Battelle edits biographies only for typographical and grammatical accuracy and to ensure they remain under the 250-character limit.
